
How to Build with BILT-E-Z

Construction with Bilt-E-Z outfits will be a very simple matter if the instructions set forth in these few paragraphs are carefully followed. The parts used in building are illustrated and named on page 2 of this booklet.


The floor pieces are joined together by placing one-half of a friction piece into a floor and the other half into the adjoining floor. The dotted lines in illustration "B" show the correct position of the friction piece inside the floor.



The first operation in the erection of any Bilt-E-Z structure is to join together floor pieces according to the desired plan of the first floor. In order that your building shall be perfectly solid and substantial it is absolutely necessary that all floor pieces be placed with the thick edges down and facing the same way throughout the entire building. If you fail to follow these instructions your structures will not be rigid.




A cross sectional view showing the manner in which two stories are joined together




After the floor has been joined together in the desired shape, you are then ready to place the edges of the walls and windows in the grooves of the floor pieces. If your building is going to be more than four squares each way. it will be necessary to brace it by placing supporting walls between every second floor. These supporting walls are inserted in the manner shown in illustration "C."










After the windows and walls have been inserted in their place, you are ready to start on the next floor. The easiest way to add another floor is to put the pieces of the second floor together before placing them over the floor below. If the building is over four squares wide or deep this may be accomplished by placing the second floor on top of the first floor in two or more sections of connected floor parts. The second floor is held in position by inserting the upper edge of walls and windows into the grooves of the second floor as indicated in illustration "D.

All floors throughout the entire building are added and held in position in exactly the same manner as the height of your structure increases. The floors must be shaped according to your plans. Illustration "E" shows how simple this is to accomplish.



The cornices and balconies furnish the necessary realistic and artistic touch to every completed building. These cornices and balconies, which greatly add to the beauty of your structure, are placed into position by inserting their protruding prongs into the grooves of the floor. See cornices and balconies on page 2.



The slanting roofs shown on some buildings are made by connecting floor pieces in the correct size and then bending the friction pieces where you desire the bend to come. You can bend your friction pieces into any desired angle.

The backs of buildings "1," "3," "4," "5" and "6" are models made perfectly flat and are constructed almost entirely of walls. Model "2," which



If when attempting to build models not shown in the book you are short a few pieces to complete your structure, do not forget that extra pieces may be purchased as shown on page 2 of this book.



All buildings shown as examples of what can be built of a set "B" are finished flat on the rear and as many walls as possible are used.










