CLEAR BRICKS USED AS SKYLIGHT, CAN ALSO BE USED FOR WINDOWS

ROOF BUILT BY STEPPING BRICKS BACK ONE NOTCH FOR GREATER REALISM USE SLOPING BRICKS (SUPPLEMENTARY BOXES) 280/283

OVERHANGING EAVES FOR ADDED REALISM

ALWAYS LOCK BRICKS ACROSS JOINS IN PREVIOUS LAYER LIKE THIS
